COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 463, L.D. 682, Bill, "An Act To
Ensure the Administration of Written Driving Tests"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and
inserting the following:

'Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1304, sub-§1-A, ¶C, as enacted by PL 2013, c. 493, §1, is
amended to read:

C. Any required examination for a learner's permit may be administered only by the
Secretary of State except that the Secretary of State may waive this requirement on
receipt of a course completion certificate under section 1351, subsection 3.

SUMMARY

Current law provides that any required examination for a learner's permit may be
administered only by the Secretary of State, and the bill clarifies the Secretary of State's
authority regarding these examinations. This amendment, which strikes and replaces the
bill, provides that the Secretary of State may waive this requirement on receipt of a Maine
driver education course completion certificate. The amendment also strikes the
emergency preamble and emergency clause from the bill.
