COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 465, L.D. 684, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Authorized Hours during Which Liquor May Be Sold and Purchased"

Amend the bill in section 5 in paragraph C in the 2nd line (page 2, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "midnight" and inserting the following: 'midnight 1 a.m. the following day'

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, provides that vessels licensed to sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption may do so until 1 a.m. of the following day, which is consistent with the time allowed for other on-premises licensees under current law.
