Amend the resolution by striking out all of subsection 2 (page 1, lines 5 to 24 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

18 2. Referral to electors unless enacted by the Legislature without change; 19 number of signatures necessary on direct initiative petitions; dating signatures on petitions; competing measures. For any measure thus proposed by electors, the number 20 21 of signatures of voters from each congressional district shall not be less than 10% of the 22 total vote for Governor cast in that congressional district in the last gubernatorial election 23 preceding the filing of such petition. The date each signature was made shall be written 24 next to the signature on the petition. A signature is not valid if it is dated more than one 25 year prior to the date that the petition was filed in the office of the Secretary of State. The measure thus proposed, unless enacted without change by the Legislature at the session at 26 27 which it is presented, shall be submitted to the electors together with any amended form, 28 substitute, or recommendation of the Legislature, and in such manner that the people can 29 choose between the competing measures or reject both. When there are competing bills 30 and neither receives a majority of the votes given for or against both, the one receiving 31 the most votes shall at the next statewide election to be held not less than 60 days after 32 the first vote thereon be submitted by itself if it receives more than 1/3 of the votes given 33 for and against both. If the measure initiated is enacted by the Legislature without 34 change, it shall not go to a referendum vote unless in pursuance of a demand made in 35 accordance with the preceding section. The Legislature may order a special election on 36 any measure that is subject to a vote of the people.'
