3 **SUMMARY**

4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to reduce the regulatory burden on a physician assistant who is  
6 currently required to be licensed by both the Board of Licensure in Medicine and the  
7 Board of Osteopathic Licensure if that physician assistant is supervised by both allopathic  
8 and osteopathic physicians. The bill proposes to require one of the physician licensing  
9 boards to issue all the licenses needed by a physician assistant, regardless of which board  
10 licenses the supervising physician.
