4 5 6	A. Shoot at any wild animal or wild bird from any public paved way or within 10 100 feet of the edge from the center of the pavement of the public paved way or from within the right-of-way of any controlled access highway;

23	SUMMARY
24	This bill:
25 26	1. Imposes a mandatory \$500 penalty for a violation of discharging a firearm or crossbow within 100 yards of a building or residential dwelling;
27 28	2. Increases the minimum distance for discharging a firearm to 100 feet from the center of a paved road and sets a penalty of \$500 for a violation; and
