1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §6602, sub-§13** is enacted to read:

3 **13. Beverages.** A public school that participates in the National School Lunch
4 Program may sell only the following beverages:

5 A. Water;

6 B. One hundred percent fruit or vegetable juice with no added sugar;

7 C. No-fat or low-fat milk, including flavored milk; and

8 D. Sparkling water with natural flavoring

9 **SUMMARY**

10 This bill limits the beverages public schools that participate in the National School
11 Lunch Program may sell to water, 100% fruit or vegetable juice with no added sugar, no-
12 fat or low-fat milk, including flavored milk and sparkling water with natural flavoring.
