1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §695, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 161, §6, is amended to read:
4 5 6	3. Results declared. As soon as the ballots are counted, the warden shall declare the results publicly at the voting place and the municipal clerk shall post the results in a place accessible to the public so that they may be viewed when the municipal office is closed.
