It clarifies that increases to 13 reimbursement rates of the dental codes in the resolve are to be made in 5 equal increases. 14 The amendment requires the Department of Health and Human Services to amend the 15 rules under Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter II, Section 25 to cover 16 diagnostic and preventive services to pregnant women and postpartum women and dental 17 services necessary to avoid more costly medical or dental care as identified by a 18 stakeholder group. It requires the Department of Health and Human Services to provide 19 information concerning adult dental benefits to adult MaineCare members and providers. 20 It requires the department to adopt rules by January 1, 2016 relating to dental coverage 21 for pregnant women and postpartum women and for services provided to avoid more 22 costly medical or dental care. The amendment also adds an appropriations and 23 allocations section. The amendment also changes the title and adds a fiscal note.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) of \$1,187,721 in fiscal year 2015-16 and \$2,840,764 in fiscal year 2016-17 to incrementally adjust the MaineCare reimbursement rates for certain dental services annually over the next 5 years until the rates reach the 10th percentile of the fees for the New England region in the most recent "Survey of Dental Fees" published by the American Dental Association, to add restorative, diagnostic and preventive dental services to pregnant and postpartum women for one year after delivery, and to cover Automated Client Eligibility System (ACES) and Maine Integrated Health Managment Solution changes, testing and Office of Information Technology oversight. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations will also be required for the FMAP match. An Other Special Revenue Funds allocation is also included in fiscal year 2015-16 to allow expenditure of DHHS allocation plan revenue received for ACES changes.
