COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 611, L.D. 892, Bill, "An Act To Amend Certain Laws Affecting the Judicial Branch"

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1 and 2.

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the bill by removing the provisions eliminating the requirements that the District Court file a monthly report with the State Auditor regarding fines, surcharges and assessments imposed by the court and that clerks of judicial courts account to the State Auditor for all fees received by them or payable to them under oath.
