The Secretary of State's budget includes sufficient funds to accommodate one ballot of average length for the general election in November. If the number or size of the referendum questions requires production and delivery of a second ballot, an additional appropriation of \$107,250 may be required.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

If approved by the voters, the bill would require printing an additional 4 pages of the constitution. Any additional printing costs could be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
