4	the State's real estate sales agent licensure requirements to determine if additional sales	
5	agent course hours are necessary to provide for an increase in the standard of	
6	demonstrated proficiency in this industry and to review the process for establishing a	
7	clearinghouse to track continuing education classes taken by real estate sales agents. The	
8	Real Estate Commission is required to submit a report with any recommended legislation	
9	to the Joint Standing Committee on Labor, Commerce, Research and Economic	
10	Development. Finally, the amendment authorizes the Joint Standing Committee on
