9. Emergency response costs. A person who, while committing OUI under this
section, proximately causes an incident requiring an appropriate emergency response by a
private or public law enforcement agency, fire department or organization that provides
emergency medical services is liable for the costs of that response up to an amount of
\$2,500.

## **SUMMARY**

9 This bill makes a person who, while criminally operating a motor vehicle while 10 intoxicated, proximately causes an incident requiring an emergency response liable for 11 the costs of that response up to an amount of \$2,500.
