6 Initiative: Provides ongoing funds to the Southern Maine Community College to support
7 economic growth and the operation of the new Midcoast Campus at Brunswick Landing.
8 The funding supports academic programming in composites manufacturing, nursing,
9 business and the arts and sciences, and assures student success through advising, library
10 and tutoring services.
