
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 342,
L.D. 970, Bill, "An Act Regarding Advanced Practice Registered Nurse Requirements"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the first paragraph after the title the following:

'Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 5-A in the last blocked paragraph in the last line (page 2, line 2 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "board" the following: except that in order to be a licensed independent practitioner a certified nurse practitioner must practice for at least 24 months under the supervision of a licensed physician or a supervising nurse practitioner or must be employed by a clinic or hospital that has a medical director who is a licensed physician'

SUMMARY

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" and requires a certified nurse practitioner to meet certain practice or employment requirements in order to be a licensed independent practitioner.
