3	7. Replacement of eyeglasses with expired prescription. Notwithstanding any
4	other provision of this section, upon presentation of an expired prescription for
5	ophthalmic lenses by a patient, an optometrist shall dispense a set of eyeglasses with the
6	prescribed ophthalmic lenses and advise the patient of the consequences of not renewing
7	the prescription by receiving an eye examination under subsection 3. An optometrist is
8	immune from liability in complying with this subsection.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill requires an optometrist, upon presentation of an expired prescription for
11	ophthalmic lenses by a patient, to dispense without liability prescription glasses pursuant
12	to the expired prescription and to inform the patient of the consequences of not renewing
13	the prescription by receiving a proper eye examination.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

1
