## SUMMARY

This amendment provides that only the home address and home telephone number of a professional investigator or investigative assistant are confidential.

9 This amendment revises the structure of the language in the bill to clarify when 10 personally identifying information concerning dependents of members of the United 11 States Armed Forces or state military forces who are deployed out of state may be 12 disclosed. It also provides that "dependent" has the same meaning as provided in 10 13 United States Code, Section 1072.
