It specifies that the job training programs must be established at the community colleges; 2. It specifies that the centers may work with trade associations as well as private businesses and that costs for the job training programs may be provided by an industry partnership; and 3. It clarifies that, in selecting awardees for the program, the Board of Trustees of the Maine Community College System shall consider various factors as they relate to the business or industry partnership.
