## An Act To Require Motorized Scooters To Be Equipped with Flags

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2063, sub-§6-A is enacted to read:

7

6-A. Safety flag. A motorized scooter may not be operated on a public way unless it
is equipped with a reflective or fluorescent flag that extends not less than 5 feet above the
ground attached to the rear of the motorized scooter. The flag must be triangular in shape
with an area of not less than 30 square inches.

- SUMMARY
- 8 This bill provides that a motorized scooter may not be operated on a public way 9 unless the motorized scooter is equipped with a reflective or fluorescent safety flag.
