3	SUMMARY
4	This amendment is the majority report of the committee. The amendment strikes
5	from the bill the definition of "public easement" and defines that term instead by
6	reference to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 23, section 3021, subsection 2 and provides
7	a definition of "emergency responder." The amendment provides an exception for an
8	emergency responder that is similar to the exception in current law for a law enforcement
9	officer.
