COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 743, L.D. 1082, Bill, "An Act To Ensure Equitable Support of Education for Maine Students in School Administrative District No. 6 and School Administrative District No. 44"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, Relating to the Member Municipalities in School Administrative District No. 6'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. Negotiation. Resolved: That the Town of Frye Island and the other member municipalities in School Administrative District No. 6 or their representatives, referred to in this resolve as "the parties," shall negotiate in good faith in order to reach a settlement of the disputes between the parties regarding:

1. The method of determining the proportional share of the local cost of education for the Town of Frye Island and the other member municipalities in School Administrative District No. 6; and

2. The provisions for the Town of Frye Island to withdraw from School Administrative District No. 6; and be it further

Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That, no later than December 11, 2015, the parties shall submit a report that includes their findings and recommendations, including suggested legislation, regarding any necessary changes to the method of determining the proportional share of the local cost of education for the Town of Frye Island and the other member municipalities in School Administrative District No. 6 for kindergarten to grade 12 and to the enacted law provisions related to the authorization and procedures necessary for the Town of Frye Island to withdraw from School Administrative District No. 6 to the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs; and be it further
