1 **Sec. 1. Department of Administrative and Financial Services to collect**
2 **information. Resolved:** That the Department of Administrative and Financial
3 Services shall collect and compile information on staffing levels, caseload and workload
4 averages, turnover rates and use of overtime for each job title in each department of the
5 State and shall review any available studies comparing private sector positions and pay
6 with comparable state positions and pay for comparable work. The department shall draft
7 a report based upon this information to identify risks to public safety and the safety of
8 workers; and be it further

9 **Sec. 2. Report. Resolved:** That, by January 4, 2016, the Department of
10 Administrative and Financial Services shall submit its report under section 1 to the Joint
11 Standing Committee on State and Local Government.

12 SUMMARY

13 This bill directs the Department of Administrative and Financial Services to collect
14 and compile information concerning staffing of all the departments of the State and
15 review any available studies comparing private sector positions and pay with comparable
16 state positions and pay for comparable work and to report its findings to the Joint
17 Standing Committee on State and Local Government.
