Electronic smoking device. "Electronic smoking device" means a device used 17 to deliver nicotine or any other substance intended for human consumption that may be 18 19 used by a person to simulate smoking through inhalation of vapor or aerosol from the device, including, without limitation, a device manufactured, distributed, marketed or 20 sold as an electronic cigarette, electronic cigar, electronic pipe, electronic hookah or so-21 22 called vape pen. 23 Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §1541, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 342, §1 and affected 24 by §9, is amended to read: 25 6. Smoking. "Smoking" includes carrying or having in one's possession a lighted or 26 heated cigarette, cigar, or pipe or other object giving off tobacco smoke a lighted or 27 heated tobacco or plant product intended for human consumption through inhalation whether natural or synthetic in any manner or in any form. "Smoking" includes the use of 28 29 an electronic smoking device.' 30 **SUMMARY** 31 This amendment, which is the majority report, changes the bill's title, replaces the defined term "electronic cigarette" with a new term, "electronic smoking device," and 32 33 definition and amends the definition of "smoking" to include use of an electronic smoking
