3 **SUMMARY**

4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to amend the standards for preconviction release by eliminating
6 cash bail and requiring a judge or justice when making bail determinations to consider
7 validated risk assessment tools. The purpose of this bill is to shift the emphasis from cash
8 to suitability for release based on risk, in order to ensure the defendant's appearance in
9 court and to prevent the defendant from committing new crimes.
