With the intent of adopting a child, intentionally or knowingly provides, or offers to provide, the parent of that child or the person whose consent is required pursuant to Title 18-A, section 9-302 with monetary payment or other valuable consideration that is not authorized by Title 18-A, section 9-306.

28 29 30	This amendment provides a new title for the bill, replaces the bill and prohibits, within the context of an adoption of a child, any payment that is not authorized under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 18-A, section 9-306.
