19 20 21 22 23	This amendment strikes all of the sections of the bill except for the provision that requires the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices to provide a form to political action committees on which the treasurer or principal officer of a political action committee pledges not to spend money in a Maine Clean Election Act candidate's race. The amendment also clarifies that the pledge is voluntary.	

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
