Any executive session includes only commissioners who are physically present at 28 the location of the public proceeding identified in the notice.' 29 **SUMMARY** 30 This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary 31 and amends the bill to bar remote participation in executive sessions of the board and 32 authorities subject to the bill and lists specific and limited situations when a member may

participate remotely in the public proceedings.

33
