2	Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §752, sub-§§1-A and 4-A are enacted to read:
3 4	<b>1-A. Dynamic sign.</b> "Dynamic sign" means an electronic sign capable of displaying a changing message.
5	4-A. Traffic beacon. "Traffic beacon" means a light used for traffic control.
6	Sec. 2. 35-A MRSA §761, sub-§4 is enacted to read:
7 8 9	4. Municipalities; state agencies. This chapter does not apply to an employee or independent contractor engaged on behalf of a municipality or state agency to maintain or install traffic signals, traffic beacons, dynamic signs or luminaires.

11 12 13 14	This bill provides an exemption from the Overhead High-voltage Line Safety Act to an employee or independent contractor engaged on behalf of a municipality or state agency to maintain or install traffic signals, traffic beacons, dynamic signs or luminaires within 10 feet of overhead high-voltage lines.
