1 2	<b>Emergency preamble. Whereas,</b> acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and			
3 4	<b>Whereas,</b> senior citizens are often the targets of fraudulent and exploitive financia schemes; and			
5 6 7 8	Whereas, personal financial management assistance for those senior citizens who are no longer able to manage their finances could decrease the number of senior citizens who are taken advantage of financially and allow them to continue to live independently and			
9 10	Whereas, this legislation provides such assistance and needs to take effect as soon as possible to prevent further abuse; and			
11 12 13 14	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now therefore,			
15	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
