1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 **CONCEPT DRAFT** 3 **SUMMARY** 4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208. 5 This bill proposes to enact measures to encourage municipalities to review and reassess municipal regulations that create barriers to redevelopment in downtowns and on 6 main streets. As part of a review and reassessment, a municipality shall consider: 7 8 1. Assessing current community needs and environmental impacts of the regulations; 9 Lessening the impact of excessive parking requirements for buildings in 10 downtowns and on main streets; and 3. Extending so-called grandfather provisions relating to the reuse of upper floors of 11 12 buildings in downtowns and on main streets.
