COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 538, L.D. 1430, Bill, "An Act To Allow Hunters Whose Religion Prohibits Wearing Hunter Orange Clothing To Instead Wear Red"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-A in the last line (page 1, line 5 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "clothing" the following: 'and the person is hunting on the person's own land. Articles of red clothing permitted under this subsection must have an excitation purity not less than 85% and luminance factor of not less than 40%'

Amend the bill in section 2 in the 5th line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "required by current law" and inserting the following: 'pursuant to the requirements of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 11203, subsection 1-A'

Amend the bill in section 2 in the 6th line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "the Maine Revised Statutes,"

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that a person may substitute articles of red clothing with a specified excitation purity and luminance factor for articles of hunter orange clothing, as long as the person is hunting on the person's own land.
