HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1026,
L.D. 1503, Bill, "An Act To Create a Class II Limited Lobster and Crab Fishing License
and Improve the Limited-entry System"

Amend the amendment in section 9 in paragraph A-3 in subparagraph (1) in the 2nd
line (page 4, line 31 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "6422" the
following: 'before attaining 18 years of age'

SUMMARY

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" by adding a provision to the
requirement that a person under 23 years of age has logged time fishing in the apprentice
program, in addition to other requirements, to be eligible to declare a limited-entry zone
as that person's declared lobster zone to also require that the person log time prior to
attaining 18 years of age.
