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

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1031, L.D. 1508, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Distribution and Off-site Storage of Spirits by Licensed Reselling Agents"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in paragraph C in the 2nd line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "30" and inserting the following: '30 20'

**SUMMARY**

The bill allows a reselling agent to sell spirits to an on-premises licensee at a licensed off-site facility, which under current law may be located no further than 30 miles from the reseller's agency liquor store. This amendment reduces that distance to 20 miles.
