COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 586, L.D. 1524

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1 facilities and other facilities authorized by the Board of Trustees of the Maine Veterans' 2 Homes, using available funds. Any funds loaned to the Maine Veterans' Homes for 3 operating purposes from the funded depreciation accounts of the Maine Veterans' Homes 4 must be reimbursed from any funds received by the Maine Veterans' Homes and available 5 for that purpose. The primary purpose of the Maine Veterans' Homes is to provide 6 support and care for honorably discharged veterans who served on active duty in the United States Armed Forces or who served in the Reserves of the United States Armed 7 8 Forces on active duty for other than training purposes."

SUMMARY

Same

This amendment, which is the minority report, maintains existing law that prescribes the number of beds at various Maine Veterans' Homes locations but strikes the provisions that establish the number of beds that certain facilities may not exceed. The amendment maintains the requirement that some facilities have a specific number of beds dedicated to dementia patients. The bill proposes to remove any specific requirements for the number of beds at any facility and for the location of the facilities, which have already been constructed.
