18	§3851. Provision of ballistic vests for law enforcement
19 20	1. <b>Definitions.</b> As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.
21 22 23	A. "Ballistic vest" means a form of personal armor worn on the torso that prevents o restricts penetration by a projectile discharged by a firearm as defined in Title 17-A section 2, subsection 12-A.
24	B. "Law enforcement officer" means an active:
25	(1) State police officer;
26 27	(2) Game warden or other law enforcement officer employed by the Departmen of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife or any bureau or division of the department;
28 29	(3) Employee of the Office of the State Fire Marshal who has law enforcemen powers pursuant to section 2396, subsection 7;
30	(4) Judicial marshal

21 22	2. Provision of ballistic vests for law enforcement officers. A law enforcement officer employed by the State must be provided a well-fitting, contemporary ballistic vest.		
23 24 25	3. Provision of ballistic vests for dogs engaged in law enforcement. If the State uses a dog for the purpose of aiding in law enforcement, the dog must be provided a well-fitting, contemporary ballistic vest.		
26 27	4. Funding. The State may accept public and private funds to implement the purposes of this chapter.
