SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 625,
L.D. 1574, Bill, "An Act To Protect Maine Voters from Intimidating Videotaping at the
Polls"

Amend the amendment in subsection 4 in the last line (page 1, line 24 in amendment)
by striking out the following: "at the direction" and inserting the following: "by the
municipal clerk at the recommendation"

SUMMARY

The bill, as amended by Committee Amendment "A," authorizes the warden to
remove from the voting place a person who is video recording closer than 15 feet from a
voter being recorded. This amendment instead provides that it is the municipal clerk, at
the recommendation of the warden, who is authorized to remove such a person.
