Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill provides a sales tax exemption to all federally-chartered veterans' service organizations. It would result in a loss of General Fund revenue of \$7,840 in fiscal year 2015-16 and \$87,868 in fiscal year 2016-17 and a loss to the Local Government Fund of \$163 in fiscal year 2015-16 and \$1,793 in fiscal year 2016-17.
