SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 680, L.D. 1663, Bill, "An Act To Promote Recruitment and Retention of State Employees"

Amend the bill in section 2 in §7065 by striking out all of subsection 5 (page 2, lines 38 to 41 in L.D.)

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the provision in the bill that provides that, in hiring an employee who has not been employed by the executive branch within the immediately preceding 12 months, an agency may offer and pay a one-time recruitment bonus to the new employee that is subject to the discretion of the agency and is removed from collective bargaining.
