COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 690, L.D. 1681, Bill, "An Act To Clarify the Appointment Process"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §75 in the first paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "at least 3" and inserting the following: 'one or more'

SUMMARY

This amendment is a minority report of the committee. It changes the number of qualified candidates for appointment that must be provided to the Governor from 3, as proposed in the bill, to one or more.
