I, Matthew Dunlap, Secretary of State, hereby certify that written petitions bearing valid signatures in excess of 87,000 electors of this State were addressed to the Legislature of the State of Maine and were filed in the office of the Secretary of State on February 1, 2016 and December 22, 2016, requesting that the Legislature consider an act entitled, "An Act To Allow Slot Machines or a Casino in York County".

I further certify that the number of signatures submitted is in excess of ten percent of the total votes cast in the last gubernatorial election preceding the filing of such petitions, as required by Article IV, Part Third, Section 18 of the Constitution of Maine, that number being 61,123.
