**ORDERS**

(4-1) On motion of Representative CASÁS of Rockport, the following Joint Order:  
(H.P. 644)

ORDERED, the Senate concurring, that the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation shall conduct a study to determine the placement of vehicle charging stations on Maine's highways. In conducting the study, the committee shall invite interested parties, including, but not limited to, the Commissioner of Transportation, or the commissioner's designee, and the Executive Director of the Maine Turnpike Authority, or the executive director's designee. The committee, with input from interested parties, shall determine the placement and structure of vehicle charging stations and the cost of installing and maintaining vehicle charging stations. The committee shall report out legislation based on the study to the Second Regular Session of the 128th Legislature implementing the committee's recommendations.
