| 2                       | Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1643 is enacted to read:  |
| 3                       | <u>§1643. Live organ donation</u>  |
| 4<br>5<br>6             | <b>1. Definition.</b> For the purposes of this section, "live organ donation" means the donation by an individual who is not deceased of all or part of an organ from that individual.   |
| 7<br>8<br>9<br>10<br>11 | <b>2. Information and education.</b> The department shall establish, maintain and operate an information service in order to educate the public on live organ donation. The information provided must include, but is not limited to, a description of the benefits of live organ donation and the impact of live organ donation on the access of a living organ donor to insurance. |
| 12<br>13                | 3. Methods of providing information. The department shall make information about live organ donation available by using the following methods:   |
| 14                      | A. A publicly accessible website maintained and updated by the department;   |
| 15                      | B. Public service announcements; and   |

| 20<br>21<br>22          | <b>1. Living organ donor.</b> For the purposes of this section, "living organ donor" means an individual who is not deceased who donates all or part of an organ from that individual.   |
| 23<br>24                | <b><u>2.</u></b> Discrimination prohibited. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an insurer authorized to do business in this State may not:  |
| 25<br>26<br>27          | A. Limit coverage or refuse to issue or renew coverage of an individual under any life insurance, disability insurance or long-term care insurance policy due to the status of that individual as a living organ donor;  |
| 28<br>29<br>30          | B. Preclude an individual from donating all or part of an organ as a condition of receiving coverage under a life insurance, disability insurance or long-term care insurance policy;  |
| 31<br>32<br>33          | C. Consider the status of an individual as a living organ donor in determining the premium rate for coverage of that individual under a life insurance, disability insurance or long-term care insurance policy; or  |
