1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §601** is repealed.

3 **SUMMARY**

4 Public Law 2013, chapter 595, Part U repealed several municipal mandates to license
5 the operation of certain businesses that offer recreational activities, such as bowling
6 alleys, shooting galleries and pool halls, and provided for the municipal licensing of those
7 businesses under home rule authority. The requirement to license roller-skating rinks was
8 not repealed when the other licensing requirements were repealed. This bill repeals the
9 statute requiring municipal officers to license roller-skating rinks.
