COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 16, L.D. 37, Bill, "An Act To Provide a Career and Technical Education Training Option for Plumbers"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph B in the 9th line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "joint" and inserting the following: 'joint'

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2-B in the 4th line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "college" the following: ', in a registered Department of Labor apprenticeship program'

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2-B in the 6th line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "3501-B" the following: 'and evidence of having obtained a passing grade, as determined by the board, on the journeyman's examination'

SUMMARY

This amendment makes technical corrections to provide consistency in the statutory language governing the qualifications for obtaining a journeyman-in-training plumbing license.
