SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 38,  
L.D. 90, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Charter of the Rumford Water District"


Amend the amendment in section 3 in the 4th and 5th lines (page 2, lines 12 and 13 in amendment) by striking out the following: "board of trustees of the Rumford Water District" and inserting the following: 'municipal officers of the Town of Rumford'

Amend the amendment in section 3 in the 2nd to last paragraph in the first line (page 2, line 25 in amendment) by striking out the following: "board of trustees of the Rumford Water District" and inserting the following: 'municipal officers of the Town of Rumford'

SUMMARY

This amendment allows the municipal officers of the Town of Rumford, instead of the board of trustees of the Rumford Water District, as in the committee amendment, to submit to the legal voters of the district the question of whether the charter for the district should be amended to require that the legal voters of the district elect trustees, instead of having trustees appointed by the municipal officers as the charter currently requires.
