12 (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "victim" the following: 'if the
13 crime is committed on or after October 1, 2017'

14 Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A in subparagraph (5) in the last line (page
15 1, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~and~~" and inserting the following: 'and'

16 Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A in subparagraph (6) in the last line (page
17 1, line 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and"

18 Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A by striking out all of subparagraph (7)
19 (page 1, lines 19 and 20 in L.D.).

20 Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph A in subparagraph (1-A) in the last line
21 (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "victim" the following: 'if the
22 crime is committed on or after October 1, 2017'

23 Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph A in subparagraph (4-A) in the last line
24 (page 1, line 35 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "victim" the following: 'if the
25 crime is committed on or after October 1, 2017'

SUMMARY

27 This amendment is the majority report of the committee. The amendment removes
28 from the bill unlawful sexual touching. The amendment makes violations of the Maine
29 Revised Statutes, Title 17-A, section 253, subsection 2, paragraph F and section 255-A,
30 subsection 1, paragraphs K and L registrable offenses under sex offender registration
31 laws when those violations are committed on or after October 1, 2017.
