1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1483, sub-§12,** as amended by PL 2009, c. 434, §20, is
3 further amended to read:

4 **12. Certain veterans.** Automobiles owned by veterans who are granted free
5 registration of those vehicles by the Secretary of State under Title 29-A, section 523,
6 subsection 1 and automobiles owned by veterans who have been diagnosed with
7 amyotrophic lateral sclerosis;

8 **SUMMARY**

9 This bill exempts from excise tax an automobile owned by a veteran who has been
10 diagnosed with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis.
