COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 198, L.D. 265, Bill, "An Act Concerning Screening of Newborns for Lysosomal Storage Disorders"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act Concerning Screening of Newborns for Krabbe Disease'

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph D-1 in the last line (page 1, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "lysosomal storage disorders" and inserting the following: 'Krabbe disease'

Amend the bill in section 2 in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 9 and 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "disorders known as Krabbe, Pompe, Gaucher, Fabry and Niemann-Pick diseases" and inserting the following: 'disorder known as Krabbe disease'

Amend the bill by adding after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention 0143**

Initiative: Provides allocations to add to the newborn screening program the lysosomal storage disorder known as Krabbe disease.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes allocations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$67,170 in fiscal year 2017-18 and \$134,340 in fiscal year 2018-19 to add to the newborn screening program the lysosomal storage disorder known as Krabbe disease. Current newborn screening fees would be increased from \$110 to \$120 per baby in order to cover these additional costs.
