Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Increase Voter Knowledge of Bond Issues'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §651, sub-§2, ¶A, as enacted by PL 2011, c. 342, §22, is amended to read:

A. In each voting booth: one voting instruction poster prepared under section 605-A and a copy of the Treasurer of State's statement prepared pursuant to Title 5, section 152; and'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment requires that each voting booth in a polling place include a copy of the Treasurer of State's statement of bond debt when there is a bond issue on a statewide ballot.
