An Act To Authorize Auxiliary Licenses at Disc Golf Courses

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1075**, as amended by PL 2005, c. 108, §§2 and 3, is further
3 amended to read:

4 **§1075. Auxiliary licenses at ski areas, golf courses and disc golf courses**

5 **1. Licenses.** The bureau may issue one auxiliary license under this section for
6 additional premises to ~~any~~ a Class A restaurant or Class A restaurant/lounge, to a Class I
7 hotel located at a ski area ~~or~~ golf course or disc golf course, ~~or~~ to a Class I golf club or to
8 a Class I or Class V club located at a golf course or disc golf course, if the following
9 requirements are met:

10 A. The additional premises are located at the same ski area ~~or~~ golf course or disc
11 golf course where the Class A restaurant, Class A restaurant/lounge, lounge, hotel, or
12 qualified club is licensed;

13 B. Food is for sale at the additional premises, although not necessarily prepared
14 there;

15 C. The additional premises are properly equipped, including tables, chairs and
16 restrooms; and

17 D. The Department of Health and Human Services licenses the additional premises.

18 **2. Sales for consumption on slopes or courses prohibited.** This section does not
19 permit a ski area to sell liquor for consumption on the slopes away from the licensed area.
20 Except as provided in section 1075-A, a golf course or disc golf course may not sell
21 liquor for consumption on the course away from the licensed area.

22 **SUMMARY**

23 This bill authorizes the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau
24 of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations to issue auxiliary licenses for additional
25 premises located at disc golf courses.
