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Amend the bill in section 2 in §6087 in subsection 2 in paragraph A in the first 2 lines (page 1, lines 17 and 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over marine resources matters"

Amend the bill in section 2 in §6087 in subsection 5 in the last line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "the chair or"

Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 3 in the 2nd to last line (page 2, line 5 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "<u>Seaweed</u>" the following: '<u>Fisheries</u>'

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 4 and inserting the following:

9 'Sec. 4. Staggered terms. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12,
10 section 6087, subsection 3, of the initial appointments of the Seaweed Fisheries Advisory
11 Council, the Commissioner of Marine Resources shall designate the first appointment for
12 a one-year term, the next 2 appointments for 2-year terms and any other appointments for

16 This amendment is the majority report of the committee. The amendment renames 17 the Seaweed Advisory Council, as it is named in the bill, the Seaweed Fisheries Advisory 18 Council. It also adds a member who harvests seaweed and a member of the public to the 19 council. The amendment removes the requirement that the council make 20 recommendations to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction 21 over marine resources matters and removes the provision in the bill that allows the chair 22 of the council to call meetings of the council.
